
Welcome to the **European Union.**

Did you know that the European Union is made up of 28 countries and has a population of about 508 million?


Come and discover these 28 countries, colour in their flags and guess the names of their capitals from the letters that have been jumbled up. You'll see what fun it is!

If you need help, you'll find the flags, the names of the capital cities and the map of Europe at the end of the colouring book.


